Senators 'Driven' to Keep Jobs in Massachusetts

Transition[®] "Flying Car" Plans to Expand Manufacturing Operations

Woburn, MA – March 2, 2010:

Massachusetts legislators, including Senate Transportation Committee co-chair Steven Baddour (D-Methuen) and Sen. Ken Donnelly (D-Arlington) will visit the development facility of the *Transition*[®] "Flying Car" at a meeting on Monday March 8, 2010 at 1pm.

The prototype development facility for the *Transition*[®] will be open to the press during this meeting. There will be photo opportunities of the actual proof of concept "flying car" which successfully completed its initial flight-test program last year.

The legislators will be invited to sit in the vehicle and learn about the *Transition*'s technology while discussing the potential for creating hundreds of new jobs in Massachusetts. Investors and public officials from out-of-state have been in discussion with Terrafugia regarding substantial packages combining private and public funding that would require relocating the design team outside the Commonwealth. An MIT spin-off company, Terrafugia is actively looking for ways to keep its jobs and innovation in the Boston area.

Terrafugia, Inc. (ter-ra-FOO-gee-ah), is the manufacturer of the *Transition*[®] street-legal airplane which pilots can fly between local airports and drive on any road. Based in Woburn, MA, the company is comprised of a team of award-winning engineers who have been advancing the state of personal aircraft since 2006. Founded by five pilots who are graduates of MIT and supported by a world-class network of advisors and private investors, Terrafugia's mission is the innovative expansion of personal mobility. "Terrafugia" is Latin for "escape from land."
